PROGRAMS

Op Shop

The Hopestreet Op Shop runs 3 times per week (Thursdays & Fridays 9am - 4pm and Saturdays 10am - 2pm, with all proceeds going directly into funding the other weekly Hopestreet Programs. Pop in for a look, our volunteers are always up for a coffee and a chat! Alternatively if yourself or your child wanted to volunteer - get in touch, we are always on the lookout for new volunteers.

Drop-In

After school Drop-In runs on a Wednesday afternoon 3-5pm and is available for Year 6 - Year 9 Students (Please note the change in age is due to needing to minimise numbers at the youth centre at a time) Students have the opportunity to complete homework (with assistance from

Hopestreet volunteers, if necessary), as well as participate in other activities such as craft, cooking and video gaming.

Friday Youth

Friday Youth is changing format this term. We have split into 3 groups that will be running at different times on a Friday afternoon/evening. Junior Girls is for year 6-9 and will run 4-6pm, Junior Boys is also year 6-9pm and will run 5:30pm - 7 and Senior Youth will run 6:30 - 8pm at various locations. Participants will still spend time in structured activities and sharing food together. This helps to provide an atmosphere where young people can model and build positive relationships with one another, as well as providing a space to talk about the deeper things of life.

Skatelight

Skatelight is a program run on Thursday afternoons 4-6pm at Munno Para Skatepark. Volunteers from HopeStreet provide tunes, games and a BBQ. Skatelight encourages young people to participate in positive social choices that contribute to a wider, positive community. Our friends at Streetlight co run the program on Tuesdays 4-6pm at Munno Para also.

Trial Kids Club

Our new pilot program aimed at year 4-5 students who aren't old enough to attend youth but still want an engagement program. We are piloting this program on Tuesdays 3-4:30pm throughout the term

Once off Events/Training

Hopestreet also offers once-off events and training that young people can attend. We will be holding an end of year party on **Friday December 17th** for all the young people in our programs. Information about this and on future opportunities will be posted on Facebook closer to the time.
